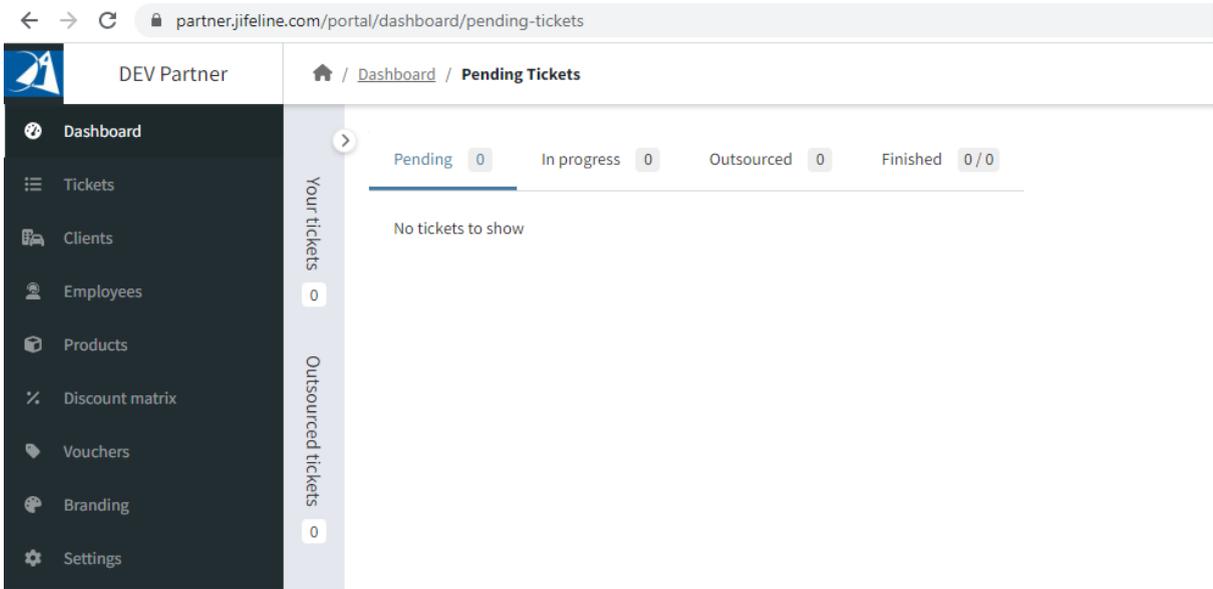


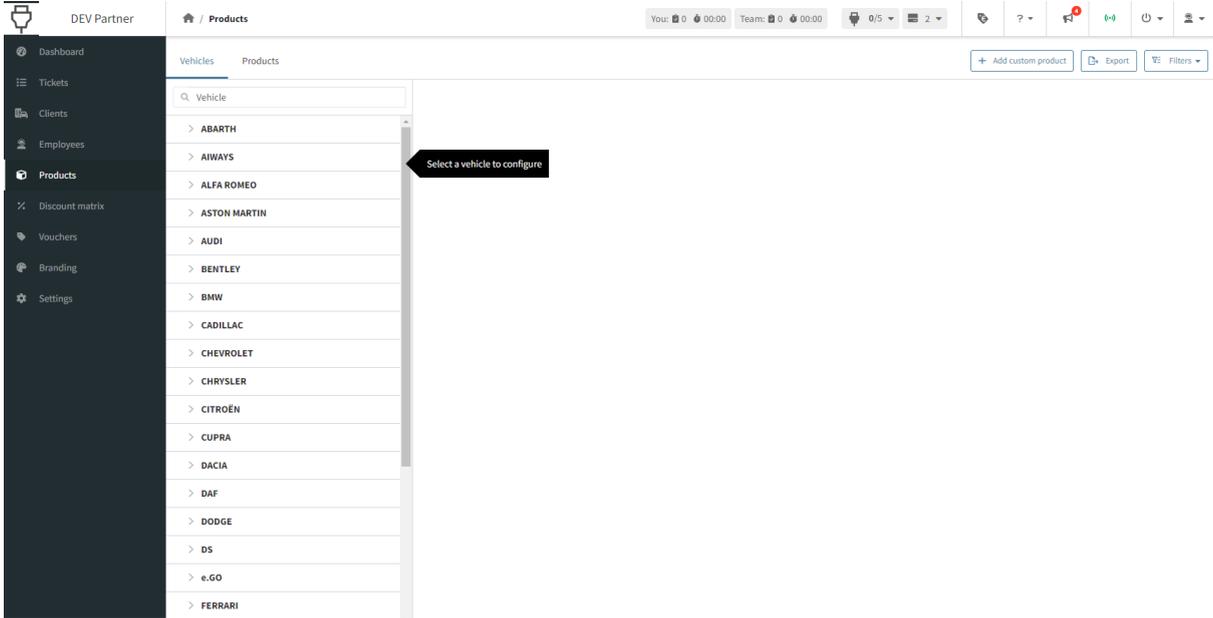

U can find the “**Products**” page on the left side of the home page, it will be displayed with a box symbol.



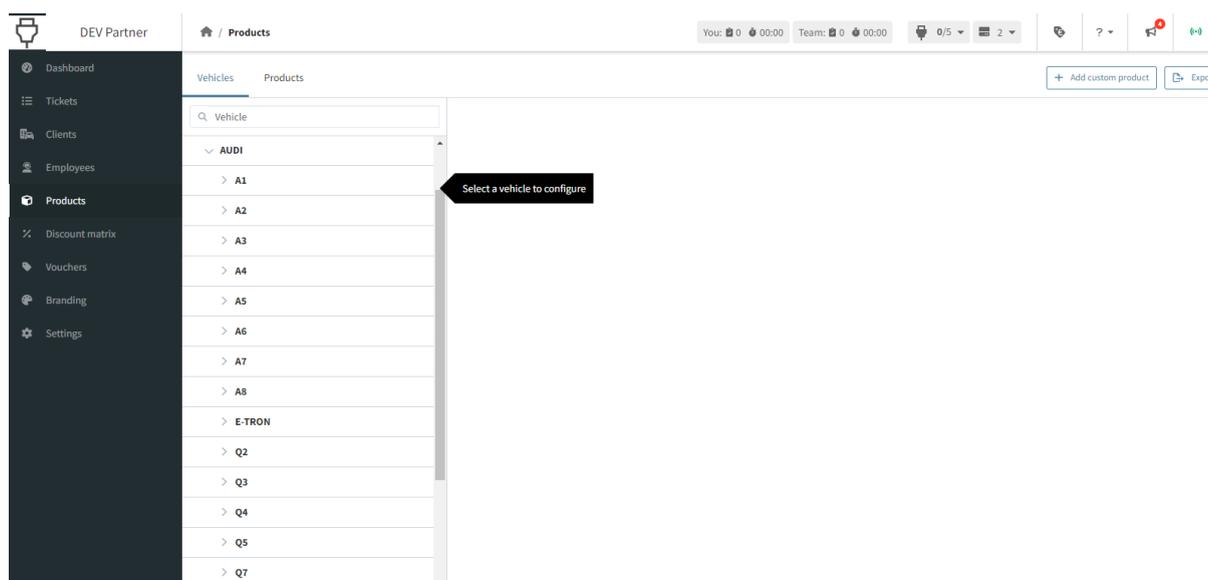

Vehicles list

Here you can find an overview of all available vehicles.

Each brand has a ">" in front of it, if you click on this you will see a dropdown menu appear. In this dropdown menu you will find all available models.

For example, if you click on the ">" button in front of Audi, you will see all Audi models groups on which we can perform services. (see image 3)

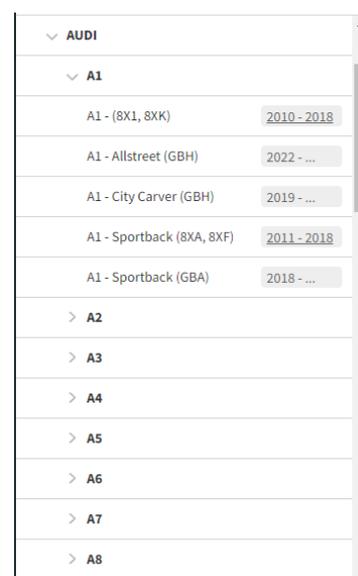

You will now see all available Audi model groups in a list. In front of each model you see a ">" button, if you click on it a dropdown menu opens with all available models. (see image 4 for example)

At the top of the screen is a search option. Here you can quick-search the vehicle you want.

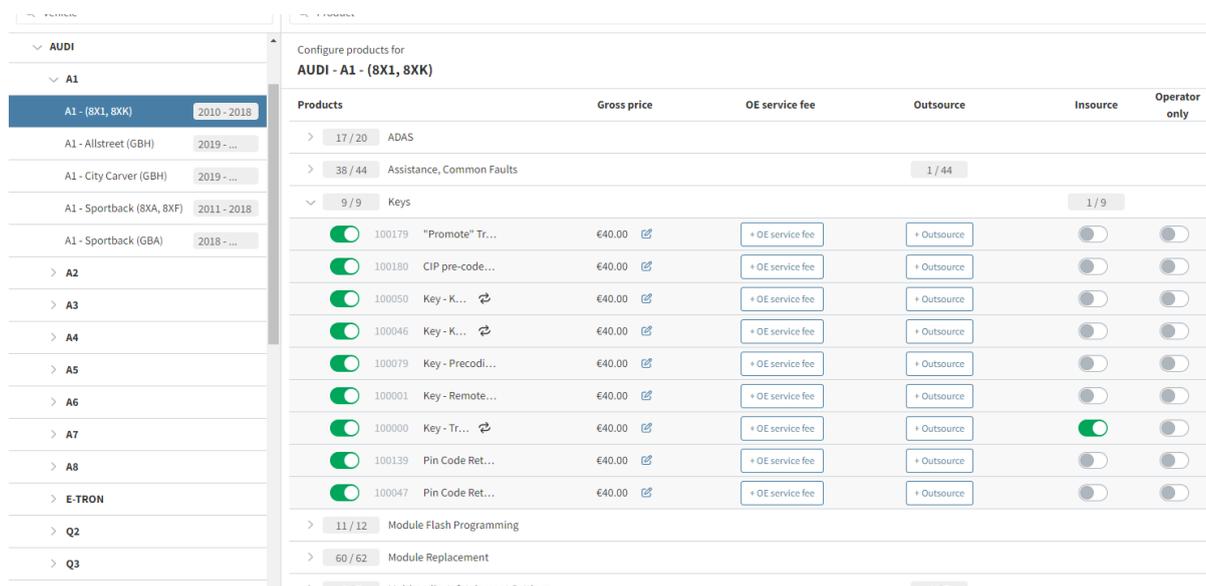
For example; you type "A1" in the bar and you will find every vehicle that corresponds to the search. So the first few results will be Audi A1 models with all the different engine options.

If you click on the Audi A1 (8X1, 8XK) you'll see the main product groups like ADAS, Keys, Module Replacement and Multimedia. Under each product group you will find an overview of the available services. (see image 5)

On this page you will see a couple of different options, these options are labeled as : *Products*, *Gross Price*, *OE service fee*, *Outsource*, *Insource* and *Operator only*. The first toggle indicates that the products are visible to both customer and operator. If the toggle in the column at the end (*Operator only*) is ON, the products can only be added by operators and not by customers.

 A green toggle indicates that the product is active and enabled.

Gross Price

Next to each service you will see a gross price. You can change this price by clicking on the  symbol next to the price.

You will now see that a field opens as follows:

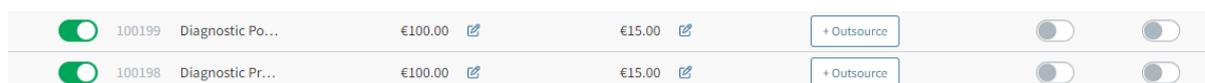

OE service fee

The OE service fee is a fixed cost item for the provider. This means that this is an amount that the provider must pay to a third party to perform the service.

For example, if you want to code a new Volvo, the provider must purchase a license from Volvo to perform this coding. This is an example of standard charges (OE service fee) for the provider to handle Volvo tickets.

If the license fee for a Volvo XC60 is €15.00, you can insert this price into the “OE service fee” option for this model in the product catalog. This way the OE fee will be included in the total ticket price. (see image 22)

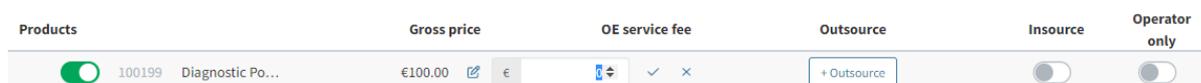
So with the "OE service fee" option you can enter a fixed price for the external costs per model/service. This way you do not have to add this manually to the invoice at a later date, but these costs are immediately charged on the invoice.

How to setup OE service fee

Look up the corresponding vehicle in the vehicle list and click on the brand and model to which you want to apply the OE service fee.

You'll now see a field with a couple of options, one of these options is the “OE service fee”. If no price has yet been added to this vehicle the option will be displayed as "". Otherwise the previous entered price will be shown here.

If you want to set the price for the OE service fee you need to click on the button that is displayed above. This will open the following window. (see image 23)

In the field that just opened, you can insert the desired price for the OE service fee for this vehicle or service. You do this by typing in the price and clicking on the “✓” behind the price to implement it in the system.

After the OE service fee price has been implemented in the system it will be calculated in the price as follows when your customer creates a ticket. (see image 24)

As you can see the 30% discount on the price of the service does not apply to the OE service fee.

The calculation of the overall ticket price including the OE service fee is :

$$(GP \times D\%) + OEsf = In. Pr.$$

GP = Gross Price

D% = Discount Percentage

OEsf = OE service fee

In. Pr. = Invoice Price

$$(\text{Service price} \times \text{discount \%}) + \text{OE service fee} = \text{price on invoice}$$

If the OE service fee does not apply to the relevant service, it will not be shown on the final invoice or cost overview of the ticket.

Auto-Outsource

Next to the header “OE service fee” you see the header “Outsource”. What can you do with outsourcing?

Briefly, this allows you to outsource a ticket to Jifeline Remote Diagnostics or another partner. This is handy if, for example: you don't have a particular tool at your disposal, another partner specializes in that specific car brand, or another partner specializes in a particular service.

For example: you have a customer and they have a new Porsche 911 where a dynamic ADAS calibration needs to be performed but you do not have the techniques or tools in-house to perform this service. You know that Jifeline has a partner who specializes in Porsche. (We will call the partner BRS for convenience). So you can define that for a ticket with a Porsche 911, from manufacture year XXXX onwards, where the service is an ADAS calibration they will be automatically outsourced to BRS. This way you can still help your customer without having the technology in-house.

If you have a vehicle or product that you are unable to work on, you can choose to auto-outsource this vehicle or product to a partner who is able to carry out the service or has the expertise.

More information on the outsource/insource options can be found via the table of contents on the left side of this document.

When you select a service provider, any incoming ticket for this combination of product and vehicle will automatically be outsourced to the selected service provider.

Here you will see the name of the outsource partner, the success rate of the service in question and the Gross Price by the outsource partner.

If you click select on the right-hand side, you will see a summary of the outsource settings for the service in question. (see image 7)

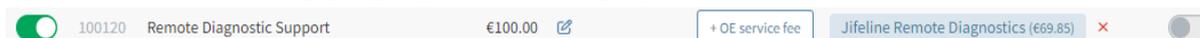

At the bottom, you will see a number of options with a toggle. If the toggle is green  it means this option is on, if the toggle is gray  it means the option is off. In these options, you can choose whether you want to share your customer database with the outsource service provider and whether you allow the outsource service provider to have direct chat contact with your customer. After clicking on save, this service is automatically outsourced to the selected service provider. If you click on the edit button, the entered settings can be changed.

If the outsource is set up properly, it will be displayed as follows:



Behind the outsource partner, *in this case Jifeline Remote Diagnostics*, you will see a red cross. The function of this cross is to stop/remove the auto-outsource connection if you no longer want to auto-outsource this service to the partner in question.

Insource

Tickets can also be outsourced from other partners to your dashboard. This is called In sourcing.

For example, if you specialize in KIA towbars and another partner does not have this expertise or related tools, then you can make a mutual agreement with the partner that all tickets related to KIA towbars will be outsourced to your dashboard. The partner who wants to outsource the tickets to your dashboard must follow the steps we have described above under "Outsource" to set this up on their dashboard.

An example is shown below. (see image 8). You can see on the right-hand side under insource that the toggle for the Key - Transponder Programming for the Audi A1 - (8X1, 8XK) glows green. This means all partners that have an outsource connection with you can outsource the tickets for a Key - Transponder Programming for the Audi A1 - (8X1, 8XK) to your dashboard if they have set the connection up properly.

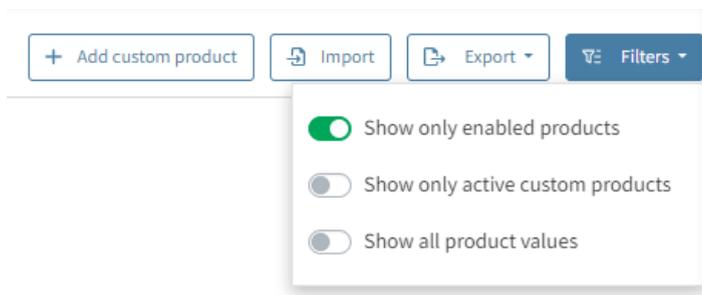

Note! You must turn on the insource toggle for each brand/model if you want tickets from this brand/model with this particular service to be outsourced to your dashboard.

Filters

At the top right of the page, you will see a filter box. If you open it a dropdown menu will appear with the following options. (see image 9)

The "Show only enabled products" option allows you to filter in your Vehicle / Product catalog by products (services) that are enabled.



This means that if the toggle is set to green you can only see services/products that are active and enabled.

All other services/products are no longer visible to you. This way, you keep track of which services/products you can perform and which you cannot.

The "Show only active custom products" option allows you to filter in your Vehicle / Product catalog by services/products that are active.

An active service means that the service in question is available in your catalog but it does not mean it's enabled for your customers.

Active indicates that the service/product could be executable if you enabled this service/product in your catalog. As opposed to the "Show only enabled products" filter where you only see the services/products that you can perform directly.

If you activate the "Show only active custom products" filter, you will see an overview of all services/products that are integrated into your product catalog but are not available for your customers to choose. These services/products are not enabled because you specified this yourself when creating the catalog. You can easily enable a service by looking up the service in your product catalog and setting the toggle for the service to green. The toggle indicates whether a service is available or unavailable to your customers and whether you can perform it. (see image 10)

A green toggle indicates that you offer this service to your customers.

A gray toggle indicates that you are NOT offering this service to your customers.

In this case both services are active but only one of them is enabled.

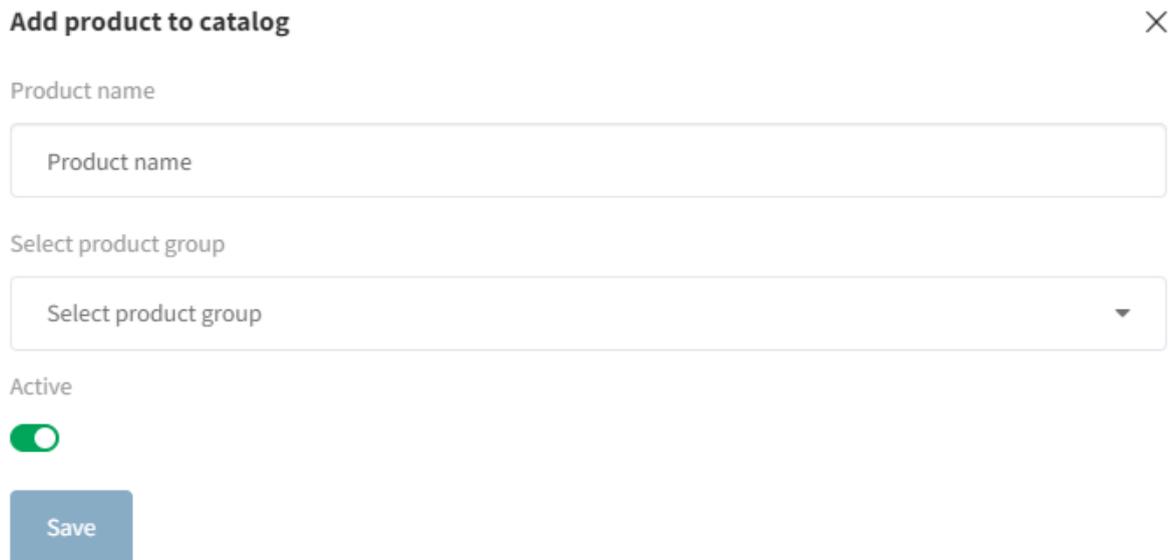
The filter: "show all product values" or "show all vehicle values" on the other tab. These filters are not the same on the different tabs!

It can happen that a product-vehicle combination is disabled but has a price on it, for example, in which case you can see all settings with this filter.

Add Custom Product

At the top right of the "Products" page, you will find the "+ Add custom product" button. This allows you to create your own service in your catalog. If a custom product has not yet been used on a ticket, it can still be deleted. If the product has already been used once, this is no longer possible.

Clicking this button opens the following field (see image 11).

In this field, you will see the following fields called "Product name", "Select product group" and "active".

Product Name

In the "Product Name" field, enter the name of the service you want to add. This is the name of the service and is not linked to a car brand/model, you can do this later by looking up the service in your catalog and enabling it for the relevant car/model. Make sure the name clearly describes what the service performs to prevent misunderstandings between you and your customers.

For example, a good product name would be :
Backward Facing Camera for Automated Driving Replacement.

This clearly indicates what the service entails and what it does on the car.

Select Product Group

In the "Select Product Group" field, you choose which group this service belongs to.

For example, the *Backward Facing Camera for Automated Driving Replacement* service falls under the *ADAS* group. So in this case you select the *ADAS* group in the drop-down menu. (See image 12 for clarification).

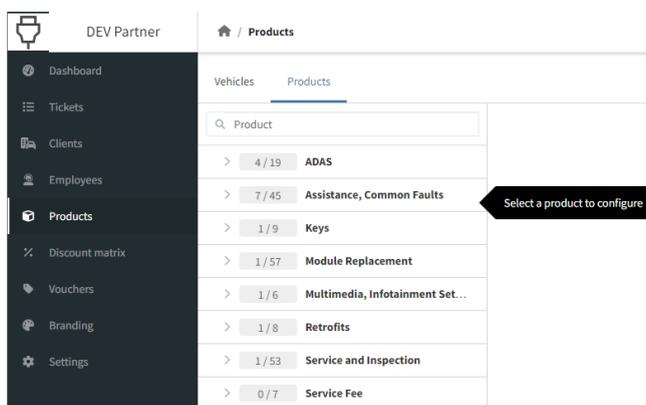
Custom Product

The custom product you just created can be found in your catalog in several ways. The most common way to find the custom product is by going to the "Products" list at the top of the page (see image 13) and clicking on the relevant product group where you added the custom product or use the search option.

Activate a product in the vehicle list

If you want to activate the custom product (*or any existing products*) for a particular car model, you need to look for your custom product in the vehicle list of the corresponding car/model and set the toggle to green.

For example, if you want to activate the custom product for the Audi A1 - (8X1, 8XK), you go to this model in the list. Click on the product group the custom product falls under. In this case, ADAS. Once you have found the product of your choice then click on the toggle to activate it. If the toggle is green then this service is active for this car model. (see image 14)

Make sure all filters are set to non-active. If this is not the case you cannot find the custom product in the list.

Extra information

Once you have activated the custom product for all car models of your choice, all you need to do is set a price. To set a price, please refer to the heading "Gross Price" in this document.

You can easily recognise a custom product by the  logo in front of the product name. If you see this logo in front of a service/product this indicates that someone in your organization/dashboard made this product.

Both the product list and the vehicle list are arranged in alphabetical order. This way, you can quickly find the correct vehicle or product in the list.

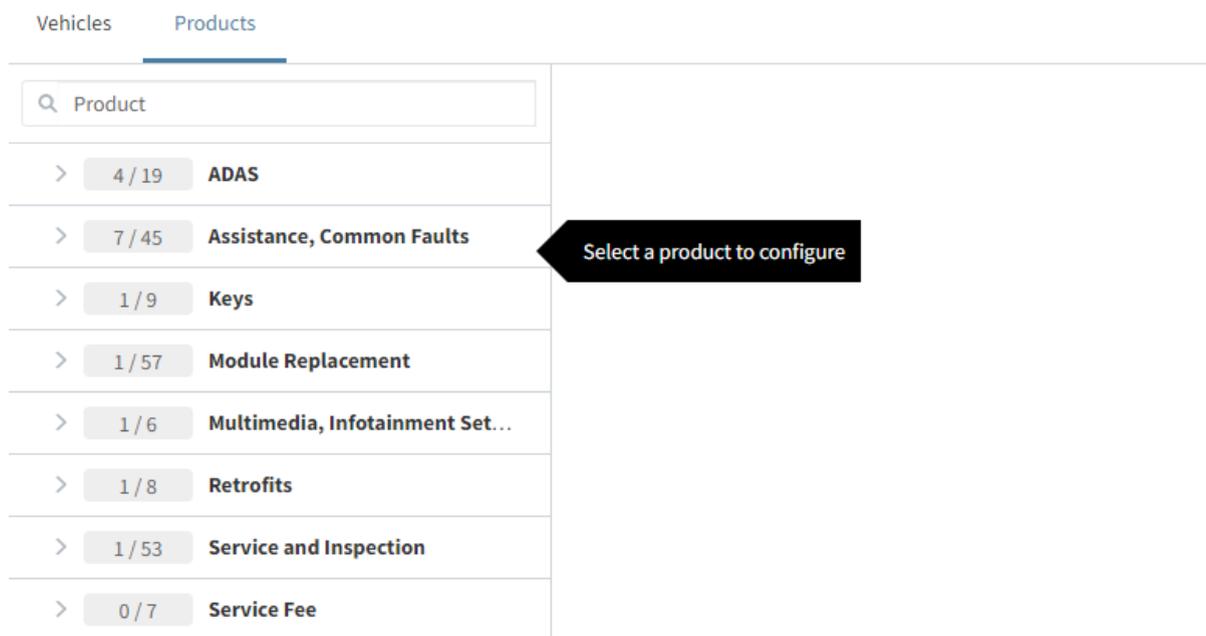
Note that a custom product is only accessible for your customers, so you cannot outsource the service to a partner. This means you also cannot insource custom services to your dashboard either.

Products List

You are now on the Vehicle list on the Products page. At the top of the page next to the heading "Vehicles" you will see the heading "Products". If you click on the heading "Products", the next page will open. (see image 15). What you now see in front of you is the product list of your dashboard.

Up to now we have described from the vehicle list point of view. From now this will be from the product list point of view.

In the product list you will see an overview of all services divided into product groups. So if you open the ADAS group, you will see an overview of all services (including custom products) that fall under ADAS.

The total number of enabled services and active services can be seen at the front of the product group. It will be displayed as > 4 / 19 ADAS

The first number before the / is the number of products that are active and can be executed. The number after the / is a total overview of all services/products executable under this product group, so this includes active products.

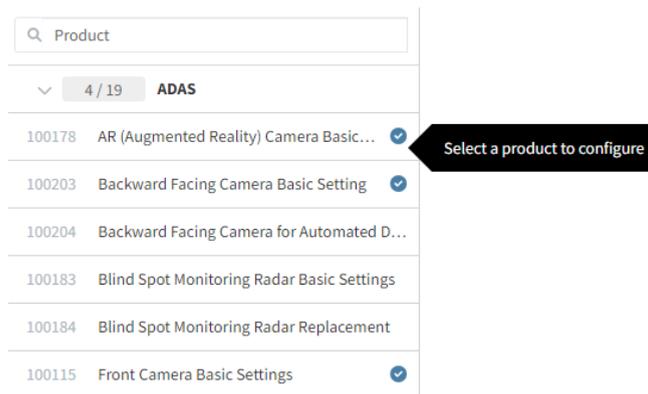
In the case of ADAS, 4 out of 19 services are possible to perform for their customers.

If you click on the product group you will see a dropdown menu open of all the products that fall under this group. So here you will see all services including the active ones.

You can easily recognise the active services because they have a  symbol behind their product name. (see image 16 on the next page)

You see a 5- or 6-digit number in front of the product name. This number is the unique article number corresponding to the product. This is needed mainly for invoicing, but you can also use the search bar at the top of the product list to quickly find a service by entering the item number.

Overview of vehicles linked to a product

You can also easily and quickly get an overview of which vehicles are activated for a particular service in the product list. You can do this by clicking on the (activated) product name in the product group. This opens the following overview (see image 17).

In this dropdown menu, you will find all vehicles for which this service is activated.

For example, if you want to know for which Alfa Romeo's models the "AR (Augmented Reality) Camera Basic Settings" service is activated, click the ">" button next to the Alfa Romeo name. Once you have done this you will get an overview of all Alfa Romeo models for which this product is activated. The overview of the total number of models is indicated in the same way as under the heading "Product List". (See paragraph 3 for a detailed explanation.) The only difference is that in this case we count in brands and models instead of products and services. (The meaning / functionality of the numbers remains the same.)

You can easily set/adjust the price for any of the models by clicking on the  symbol next to the name and correct the price (see image 18).

Select multiple vehicles

The "Select multiple vehicles" option allows you to select multiple car makes/models at the same time for a bulk action. (see image 19)

For example, if you want a service to be activated for all ABARTH and AUDI cars, simply look up the service in the product list and select it. After you select it you click on "Select multiple vehicles" at the top of the page and choose the car brands or models for which you want to activate this service. So in this example you select ABARTH and AUDI.

Bulk Action (Enable Service)

After you have selected the desired car brands/models you will see that on the right side of the page the "Bulk Action" button lights up. This is because this button corresponds to the "Select multiple vehicle" option. So you can only use the "Bulk Action" button after using the "Select multiple vehicle" option.

Let's say you want to activate the "Remote Diagnostics Support" service for all Audi and Abarth models. Select this service and click on the "Select multiple vehicles" option and select the Audi and Abarth models.

(You can also choose to activate only some models of these brands. You can do this by clicking on the ">" in front of the brand, then you will see a dropdown menu. Here you click on the models for which you want to activate or deactivate this service.)

Once you have selected the brands and/or models of your choice you then click on the "Bulk Action" button on the right-hand side of the screen. This will open the following window. (see image 20 on the next page)

If you want to activate the service for these brands/models, select the checkbox and click the toggle behind the "Change product enablement to" option. The toggle will turn green this indicates you want to activate the service. You can also deactivate services by setting the toggle to the left (gray).

Below this option you will see the option "Set Gross Price for selected vehicles", behind this option you will see a window with "€0". Here you can set the gross price for the service for these brands/models. Select the checkbox and enter the desired price.

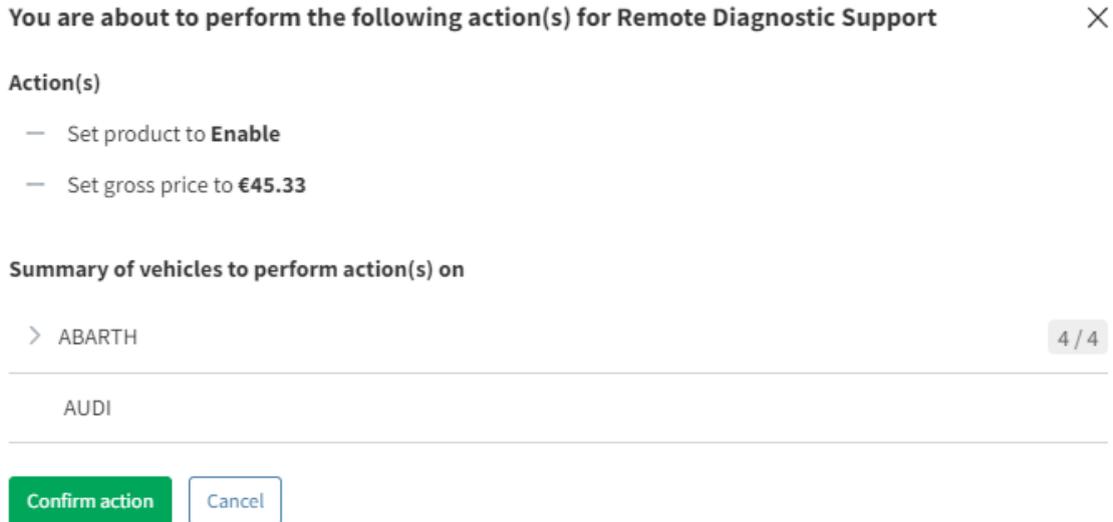

Once you have completed the options then click in the tick box that appears before the relevant option. This confirms that you want to run this option. The tick option has been implemented so that you can also run these options separately. So

you can choose to activate only the product or set only a Gross Price for these vehicles.

Once you have checked the boxes you will see the button at the bottom of the window. If you click on this button the following window will open. (see image 21)

This window will give you an overview of the action you want to take.

If you do not want to perform the action after entering the options, you can click  at the bottom right. This will close the "Bulk Action" window and take you back to your previous page. You can also close this window by clicking the "X" at the top right of the window.

If you want to proceed with the action then click the "Confirm Action" button at the bottom left of the window.

Bulk Action (Disable Service)

The "Bulk Action" option also allows you to disable services that are already active and change the Gross Price for brands and models.

For example, if you have a service enabled for all Volvo models, you can disable this service for Volvo by looking up the service in the product list. Here you select the service, click the "select multiple vehicles" option, select all Volvo models where you want to disable the service and then click the "Bulk Action" option.

The same "Bulk Action" window will open as in the steps explained above (see image 20). The only difference is that now you either turn off the toggle or adjust the Gross Price that was already at an amount to a new amount.

If you have adjusted the settings then click on the "Perform Action" button. You will now see (the same) window with the overview of adjustments you want to make (see image 21).

If you want to implement these changes then click the "Complete Actions" button at the bottom left of this window.

You will now see the same screen as image 22.

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Export

An export function has been added in the catalog. This function has been added so you can export these lists in CSV format. There is also an import function: this excel file can be shared with providers and imported via the import button. The export button thus has 2 options:

- 1) Export price list: Export enabled vehicle-product combinations
- 2) Export prod cat: Export both enabled and disabled vehicle-product combinations

To download the CSV file click on the  button at the top right of the page. If you click this you will see that the export starts downloading immediately.

It is possible that the export formatted the Excel in a different way as expected. This has to do with the settings of your Excel, if you want to change the formatting then you will have to change your own settings in Excel.
